Fifth Sunday After Epiphany

GOSPEL Matt. 13:24-30 At that time, Jesus spoke this parable to the multitudes: "The kingdom of heaven is likened to a man that sowed good seed in his field. But while men were asleep, his enemy came, and oversowed cockle among the wheat, and went his way. And when the blade was sprung up, and had brought forth fruit, then appeared also the cockle. And the servants of the good man of the house coming, said to him, Sir, didst thou not sow good seed in thy field? whence then hath it cockle? And he said to them, an enemy hath done this. And the servants said to him, wilt thou that we go and gather it up? And he said, No: lest perhaps gathering up the cockle you root up the wheat also together with it. Suffer both to grow until the harvest; and in the time of the harvest, I will say to the reapers, gather up first the cockle, and bind it into bundles to burn, but the wheat gather ye into my barn."



Saint Valentine of Terni, officially Saint Valentine of Rome, born 226 AD was a widely recognized 3rd-century Roman saint and since the High Middle Ages is associated with a tradition of courtly love.

He was a Roman Priest at a time when there was an emperor called Claudias who persecuted the church. Claudias issued an edict that prohibited the marriage of young people. This was based on the hypothesis that unmarried soldiers fought better than married soldiers because married soldiers might be afraid of what might happen to them or their wives or families if they died.

This edict immediately presented a problem to the Christian church. The idea of encouraging young people to marry within the Christian church was what Saint Valentine was about. And he secretly married them because of the edict.

Saint Valentine was eventually caught, imprisoned and tortured for performing marriage ceremonies against command of Emperor Claudius. There are legends surrounding Saint Valentine's actions while in prison.

One of the men who was to judge him in line with the Roman law at the time was called Asterius, whose daughter was blind. Saint Valentine was supposed to have prayed with and healed the young girl with such astonishing effect that Asterius himself became Christian as a result.

In the year 269 AD, on February 14th, Saint Valentine was sentenced to a three-part execution of a beating, stoning, and finally decapitation all because of his stand for Christian marriage. The story goes that the last words he wrote were in a note to Asterius' daughter. He inspired today's romantic missives by signing it, "from your Valentine."

The relics of Saint Valentine were kept in the Church and Catacombs of San Valentino in Rome, which remained an important pilgrim site throughout the Middle Ages until the relics were transferred to the church of Santa Prassede. The flower-crowned skull of Saint Valentine is exhibited in the Basilica of Santa Maria in Cosmedin, Rome; other relics were brought to Whitefriar Street Carmelite Church in Dublin, Ireland where they remain to this day

Saint Valentine has come to be known as the patron saint of lovers. If he were here today, he would say to married couples – "there comes a time where you're going to have to suffer. It's not going to be easy to maintain your commitment and your vows in marriage. Don't be surprised if the 'gushing' love that you have for someone changes to something less "gushing" but maybe much more mature."

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

We continue with the instigations of "Michael" the anti-apostle who was among a thousand, perhaps even thousands of infiltrators manifesting such hatred of God and His Church, that their one consuming passion was to destroy it. It must be said that this could be viewed as a sort of "left-handed" compliment to the Church --- for if it was not a threat to them, why were they so intent on demolishing it? On some level, they saw the truth, but hated it so resolutely, that, like Satan who engineered the crucifixion, these people were psychotically intent on destroying the Mystical Christ, which is the Church.

Last week we saw how a Communist agent known as "the Uncle" gave Michael the commission to enter the seminary, and with eventual ordination was to remain essentially invisible; masking himself as a faithful, celibate priest until death. In order to do this he had to present himself to a priest who had the gift of "reading souls." The Infiltrator recounts the event in this manner:

Nevertheless [the bishop] requested that I present myself to the pastor of my parish and also to a religious noted for having the gift of mind-reading. This gibberish simply meant that this good man was capable of detecting false vocations from the simply imaginary to the frankly perverse.

...I was much comforted, however, when I went to meet the religious whose perspicacity was so highly praised...At first sight, this man seemed hard to bear, on account of his slowness and the frequent silences that he seemed to affect.

Of course, I manifested the most exquisite modesty. It is indeed a self-styled virtue very easy to imitate. It is even a very amusing game. And I was an ace at modesty, as well as many other acts. Also...I was proud to let him know that I never had any connection with a woman and that I was altogether disinterested in sex, only good for procreation. --- I thought that this ought to be a certain sign of a vocation...An Apostle, or an Anti-Apostle, must marry only his apostolate. [However]...when I at last was called to the bishop's house, the earth seemed to open up in front of me, because the bishop quietly told me that the religious thought that I did not have a vocation.

I was not lying when I asserted that I wanted to know what had prompted this religious to refuse me the signs of a true vocation. This was important for me, because I could learn how to perfect my little religious act...I still hoped to bring this religious to reverse his decision.

When Michael the Infiltrator could not succeed in changing the priest's mind he proclaims:

Then I got up and caused death without wounds...Having caused, in two swift gestures....the death without wound of the one who had the almost comical audacity to oppose himself to Marxism-Leninism...I quietly returned home. The death would naturally be published. Cause: heart failure.
