



Third Sunday in Lent

GOSPEL Luke 11:14-28 At that time, Jesus was casting out a devil: and the same was dumb. And when He had cast out the devil, the dumb spoke: and the multitudes, were in admiration at it. But some of them said: "He cast out devils by Beelzebub, the prince of devils." And others tempting, asked of Him a sign from heaven. But He, seeing their thoughts, said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself shall be brought to desolation; and house upon house shall fall. And if Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? Because you say that through Beelzebub I cast out devils. Now if I cast out devils by Beelzebub, by whom do your children cast them out? Therefore, they shall be your judges. But if I by the finger of God cast out devils, doubtless the kingdom of God is come upon you. When a strong man armed keeps his court, those things are in peace which he possesses. But if a stronger than he come upon him and overcomes him, he will take away all his armor wherein he trusted and will distribute his spoils. He that is not with Me is against Me; and he that gathers not with Me scatters. When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walks through places without water, seeking rest: and not finding, he says: I will return into my house whence I came out. And when he is come, he finds it swept and garnished. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself: and entering in they dwell there. And the last state of that man becomes worse than the first." And it came to pass, as He spoke these things, a certain woman from the crowd, lifting up her voice, said to Him: "Blessed is the womb that bore You and the breasts that nursed You." But He said: "Rather, blessed are they who hear the word of God and keep it."



The Annunciation (from Latin *annuntiatio*), also referred to as the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is the Catholic celebration of the announcement by the Archangel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary that she would conceive and become the mother of Jesus, the Son of God, marking His Incarnation. "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled."

According to Luke 1:26, the Annunciation occurred "in the sixth month" of Elizabeth's pregnancy with John the Baptist. Many Christians observe this event with the Feast of the Annunciation on March 25th, an approximation of the northern vernal equinox nine full months before Christmas, the ceremonial birthday of Jesus.

The Annunciation is a key topic in Christian art. Depictions of the Annunciation go back to early Christianity, with the Priscilla catacomb including the oldest known fresco of the Annunciation, dating to the 4th century. It has been a favorite artistic subject in both the Christian East and as Roman Catholic Marian art, particularly during the Middle Ages and Renaissance, and figures in the repertoire of almost all of the great masters. The figures of the Virgin Mary and the Angel Gabriel, being emblematic of purity and grace, were favorite subjects of Roman Catholic Marian art, where the scene is also used to represent the perpetual virginity of Mary via the announcement by the Angel Gabriel that Mary would conceive a child to be born the Son of God.

Works on the subject have been created by artists such as Sandro Botticelli, Leonardo da Vinci, Caravaggio, Duccio, Jan van Eyck, and Murillo among others. The mosaics of Pietro Cavallini in Santa Maria in Trastevere in Rome (1291), the frescos of Giotto in the Scrovegni Chapel in Padua (1303), Domenico Ghirlandaio's fresco at the church of Santa Maria Novella in Florence (1486), and Donatello's gilded sculpture at the church of Santa Croce, Florence (1435) are famous examples.

Both the Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox Churches hold that the Annunciation took place at Nazareth, but slightly differ as to the precise location. The Basilica of the Annunciation marks the site preferred by the former, while the Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation marks that preferred by the latter.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

THE PASSION OF THE CHURCH III - THE MYSTERY OF INIQUITY

The "Mystery of Iniquity" as St. Paul refers to it is none other than the reality and the presence of evil that has been prevalent in the world since the Fall of Man. It implies that Satan is the "god of this world," and that he will have ever increasing power and influence over mankind as time goes on. This acceleration of evil will eventually culminate in the person of the Antichrist; Christ's ultimate and consummate adversary.

A major way in which the Antichrist, the False Prophet and their allies will do this is with what St. Paul calls "the operation of error:"

...God will send them the operation of error, to believe lying; that all may be judged who have not believed the truth, but have consented to iniquity....according to the working of Satan, in all power, and signs, and lying wonders, and in all seduction of iniquity to them that perish, **BECAUSE THEY HAVE NOT THE LOVE OF THE TRUTH, THAT THEY MIGHT BE SAVED.** [2 Thes.]

In other words **DECEPTION** — one of Satan's favorite and most effective tools! What better way to do this than to set up a false church that almost everyone will believe to be the True one:

Satan will set up a counter-church which will be the ape of the Church, because he, the Devil, is the ape of God. It will have all the notes and characteristics of the Church, but in reverse and emptied of its divine content. It will be a mystical body of the Antichrist that will in all externals resemble the Mystical Body of Christ...but the twentieth century will join the counter-church because it claims to be infallible when its visible head speaks *ex cathedra*. [Fulton J. Sheen, *Communism and the Conscience of the West*, Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill, 1948, pp. 24-25]

[1] The "counter-church" routinely referred to as the "Novus Ordo church," or the "Conciliar church," or the "New Order church" — the one that **SUBSTANTIALLY** altered infallible and unchangeable teaching while still manifesting the appearance of the Catholic Church. It has become the "ape" of the True Church — one could say "the operation of error."

[2] "...it is emptied of its divine content:" Not just the externals have changed — they invalidated the supernatural workings of the sacraments too. Competent theologians have demonstrated that at the very least, the Novus Ordo Ordinal, the sacramental rite that creates bishops and priests is doubtful; [it cannot create real Catholic priests and bishops]— and in sacramental and moral theology someone who formally participates in and knowingly partakes of a doubtful or invalid sacrament commits a mortal sin.

Do you have the "love of the truth" that you might be saved — or are you more concerned with other things, like convenience, habit, "what other people think," or what the deceived traditionalist establishment says? You **MUST** study these things and decide! The Passion of the Church continues, and we must live through it righteously, in spite of the Mystery of Iniquity and the operation of error.
