GOSPEL Matt. 21:1-9) At that time, and when they drew nigh to Jerusalem and were come to Bethphage, unto Mount Olive, then Jesus sent two disciples, Saying to them: "Go ye into the village that is over against you: and immediately you shall find an ass tied and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to me. And if any man shall say anything to you, say ye that the Lord hath need of them. And forthwith he will let them go." Now all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: "Tell ye the daughter of Sion: 'Behold thy King cometh to thee, meek and sitting upon an ass and a colt, the foal of her that is used to the yoke.'

And the disciples going, did as Jesus commanded them. And they brought the ass and the colt and laid their garments upon them and made Him sit thereon. And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way: and others cut boughs from the trees and strewed them in the way.

And the multitudes that went before and that followed cried, saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest."

Thus did God, in His power over men's hearts, procure a triumph for His Son, and in the very city, which, a few days later, was to clamor for His Blood. This day was one of glory to our Jesus, and the holy Church would have us renew, each year, the memory of this triumph of the Man-God. Shortly, after the birth of our Emmanuel, we saw the Magi coming from the extreme east, and looking in Jerusalem for the King of the Jews, to whom they intended offering their gifts and their adorations: but it is Jerusalem herself that now goes forth to meet

this King. Each of these events is an acknowledgment of the kingship of Jesus; the first, from the Gentiles; the second, from the Jews. Both were to pay Him this regal homage, before He suffered His Passion. The inscription to be put upon the cross, by Pilate's order, will express the kingly character of the Crucified: Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews. Pilate, the Roman governor, the pagan, the base coward, had been unwittingly the fulfiller of a prophecy; and when the enemies of Jesus insist on the inscription being altered, Pilate will not deign to give them any answer but this: 'What I have written, I have written.' Today, it is the Jews themselves that proclaim Jesus to be their King: they will soon be dispersed, in punishment for their revolt against the Son of David; but Jesus is King and will be so forever. Thus we literally verified the words spoken by the Archangel to Mary, when he announced to her the glories of the Child that was to be born of her: 'The Lord God shall give unto Him the throne of David, His father; and He shall reign in the house of Jacob forever.' [St. Luke i. 32]. Jesus begins His reign upon the earth this very day; and though the first Israel is soon to disclaim His rule, a new Israel, formed from the faithful few of the old, shall rise up in every nation of the earth, and become the kingdom of Christ, a kingdom such as no mere earthly monarch ever coveted in his wildest fancies of ambition. FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

THE PASSION OF THE CHURCH VI

For many, the attempt to explain "The Passion of the Church" might not only seem incomprehensible, but downright ridiculous. After all, I'm sure in Novus Ordo land all is well and happy — it's only the evil conservatives and/or traditionalists who are complaining — and no one listens to them.

But anyone who has eyes can see that there is a problem, even if they did not grow up at all in the time prior to Vatican II.

Almost without doubt we are in the time of the Great Apostasy of which St. Paul speaks of in 2nd Thessalonians. This is the time of a great falling away of the faith, presumably after a period of manifest accomplishment and success in mission. This describes our times exactly. The Great Apostasy comes, says the Catechism of the Council of Trent, in preparation for the rise of Antichrist. The eminent convert from Anglicanism, Cardinal Henry Edward Manning [1808-1892] published a booklet with a series of lectures entitled *The Present Crisis of the Holy See Tested by Prophecy*, which was reprinted lately with the more compelling title *The Pope and the Antichrist*. In this work, Cardinal Manning describes the Mystical Passion the Church will endure in the last age of the world, largely based upon the teaching of the Fathers of the Church and the best theological thinking of the time. The first characteristic of this Passion His Eminence says; "will be **indifference to [religious] truth".** This was brought about largely through **Ecumenism**, which by asserting that all religions are more or less equal, no religion is true. This was a major goal of Vatican II — the promotion of Ecumenism and therefore Indifferentism. People "receive not the love of the truth," as St. Paul says.

Other significant characteristics of the Church's Mystical Passion says Cardinal Manning, will be the taking away of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass* which is the setting up of the abomination of desolation in the sanctuary, the temporary overthrow of the papacy, and the apparent "death" of the Church. At this time His Eminence says:

"Then, the Church shall be scattered, driven into the wilderness, and shall be for a time, as it was in the beginning, invisible, hidden in the catacombs, in dens, in mountains, in lurking-places; for a time it shall be swept, as it were, from the face of the earth." Such is the universal testimony of the Fathers of the early centuries.

So, as stated previously the Passion of the Church will consist in [1] The Great Apostasy; [2] the Operation of Error; [3] the suppression of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass; [4] the overthrow of the Vicar of Christ. All of these things have come to pass in our lifetime — when you think of it, are we not privileged to live in these times? Four factors says Cardinal Manning enable and escalate the Great Apostasy: **Fear, Deception, cowardice & human respect.** It would be wise for us to meditate upon a very interesting passage in the Apocalypse of St. John:

But the **fearful**, and unbelieving, and the abominable and murderers, and whore-mongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, they shall have their portion in the pool burning with fire and brimstone which is the second death. [Hell] Apoc. 21:8.

But as Christ rose from the dead, out of the tomb one day the Church will emerge more glorious than ever. *The New Mass was "promulgated" by Paul VI on April 3,1969. It is the invalid abomination of desolation of which Cardinal Manning speaks.



Remember, also, Lord, Your servants and handmaids below who are gone hence before us, marked with the sign of faith, and sleep the sleep of peace. To them, Lord and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we implore You a place of happiness, light and peace through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
