## THIRTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

### GOSPEL Luke 17:11-19

At that time, as Jesus was going to Jerusalem, he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. And as he entered into a certain town, there met him ten men that were lepers, who stood afar off. And lifted up their voice, saying: "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." Whom when he saw, he said: "Go, show yourselves to the priests."

And it came to pass, as they went, they were made clean. And one of them, when he saw that he was made clean, went back, with a loud voice glorifying God. And he fell on his face before his feet, giving thanks. And this was a Samaritan. And Jesus answering, said: "Were not ten made clean? And where are the nine? There is no one found to return and give glory to God, but this stranger?" And he said to him: "Arise, go thy way; for thy faith hath made thee whole."



One of the most popular Marian devotions in the Catholic Church today is that of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, often honored alongside the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion has its roots in Sacred Scripture, which makes frequent mention of Mary's contemplative heart, for example in Luke 2:19:

"But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart."

According to Catholic doctrine, Mary is the Immaculate Conception; that is, in preparation for the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Holy Trinity in her womb, Mary was conceived without the corruption of original sin, and was preserved from committing any actual sins throughout the course of her life through the infinite merits of her Son, Jesus Christ. She was virginal not only of soul, but also of body, both before and after giving birth to Our Lord.

Our Lady was created actually "Full of Grace" as the Archangel Gabriel declared at the Annunciation, meaning that her soul was literally adorned with all of the virtues at the moment of her conception, as well as the gifts and fruits of the Holy Ghost. This fullness of grace is said to emanate from the center of her being, that is, her heart, understood both physically and spiritually. It is Mary's heart, in its unspoiled created perfection, that is the source and wellspring of her purity . . . therefore her heart is called Immaculate. Our Lord took his sacred humanity from the flesh and blood of his Blessed Mother; Christ's heart is taken from her heart. At Calvary, the perfect hearts of Jesus and Mary were united for the salvation of mankind. And this is why the Two Hearts are honored together.

While the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the source of Christ's burning love for humanity and is largely spurned by the indifference of mankind towards Him, the Immaculate Heart of Mary is the source of Our Lady's burning love for God and her desire to bring souls to her Son and is so often outraged by the offenses of mankind committed against her love.

## FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

### "EXISTENTIAL CRISIS"

John Zmirak, author of 'The Politically Incorrect Guide to Catholicism' recently Tweeted:

"The Roman Catholic Church is enduring an existential crisis. Never in the history of the Church, has any Catholic in authority said ANYTHING LIKE what @FatherRosica just claimed. No sodomite cardinal in the Renaissance, no degenerate papal made cardinal. No one. Ever.

Mr. Zmirak is referring to "Fr." Thomas Rosica, a Canadian Novus Ordo priest who represents the Vatican to the English-language media. So just what did Rosica claim? This is taken from a tribute he wrote to "Pope" Francis and his governing style:

"Pope Francis breaks Catholic traditions whenever he wants, because he is 'free from disordered attachments.' Our Church has indeed entered a new phase: with the advent of this first Jesuit pope, it is openly ruled by an individual rather than by the authority of Scripture alone or even its own dictates of tradition plus Scripture."

Rosica goes on to say: "Francis is a Dictator Pope --- thank God!"

Note well that this statement is taken from one of Francis' greatest supporters and friends, not among his critics.

A true Pope can never be a dictator in the authentic sense of the word, for he is absolutely bound by Catholic doctrine. This doctrine is, as St. Paul says in his letter to the Hebrews: "the same yesterday and today and forever." In addition, Paul warns that Christians are not to be led away by "diverse and strange teachings." If Francis has done anything almost from the very first moments of his false pontificate it was to push "diverse and strange" doctrines. Virtually no one really denies this, if they have any honesty in them at all.

The Vatican Council of 1870 infallibly teaches concerning the papacy:

"[For] the Holy Spirit was not promised to the successors of Peter that by His revelation they might make known new doctrine, but that by His assistance they might inviolably keep and faithfully expound the Revelation, the Deposit of Faith, delivered through the Apostles."

My question to you: Does this teaching of the Vatican Council fit in well with the notion that Francis is a true Pope? It is this issue that has caused many to endure an "existential crisis." But it need not, if one REALLY understands Catholic teaching on the Church and the papacy, and has the courage to think outside the usual traditionalist box.


